These products are filled with synthetic fragrances and surfactants, toxic preservatives, phosphates, optical brighteners, and ethoxylated ingredients that have been shown to cause asthma, contact dermatitis, cancer and more.

EXPOSURE TO LAUNDRY TOXINS

Triple Exposure

Laundry is a triple exposure product. We are being exposed to toxins from laundry products 24/7. We wear our clothes all day, we use towels, and sleep in our sheets!



Washer

You do laundry with detergents and softeners that contain toxic ingredients that penetrate the fibers of your clothing. The toxins are being absorbed into your bloodstream through your skin, which is your body's largest organ. Not to mention you are breathing them in all day and night!

n Dryer

Your clothing goes into the dryer (and maybe you're adding toxic dryer sheets) and those chemicals further coat or penetrate your clothing. They are literally leaving a chemical film on your clothes to make you think they are soft. They also add the synthetic scent, which makes you think your clothes are cleaner then they really are!

Pollution from dryer vents

The toxins are coming out of your dryer vents and polluting the air inside your home and you are breathing them in. Those toxins then fall to your carpets and remain in your air until you have vacuumed them up.

We have used the unscented <u>Truly Free</u> laundry detergent for about 2 years now and love it! It is great for a budget and eco friendly. They have so many other awesome products, including the <u>Dryer Angel</u> (substitute for dryer sheets)!

NOTE: There is an ingredient in the laundry detergent that is a known skin irritant. It is not toxic, but for those that have sensitive skin, this would not be the best option for you OR try the unscented option!

✓ Molly's Suds Powdered Detergents



Molly's Suds Powdered Detergent is the ONLY store option that meets MY clean standards. Make sure you are only using the powdered detergents, because their liquid formula contains Phenoxyethanol, which is a preservative on my ditch list. We love the unscented powder option!

✓ Thieves Laundry Soap

Thieves Pecipes

Thieves Laundry Soap is highly concentrated and by diluting it in a pumper bottle with water, some essential oils of choice for scent and adding in the Thieves House Hold Cleaner, it's a truly clean laundry wash that is cost effective! Here are some of my favorite recipes to make with Thieves.

FABRIC SOFTENER #1

In a 32 oz pump bottle, mix 1 part water and 1 part distilled white vinegar and 20 drops of lavender essential oil. Use 4-6 pumps per load in the fabric softener section of your washing machine.

FABRIC SOFTENER #2

In a 32 oz pump bottle, combine 1 cup toxin-free hair conditioner, 1.5 cups white vinegar, and 3 cups warm water. Mix well. Use 4-6 pumps in the fabric softener section of your washing machine.



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SCENT BOOSTER

Add 1 & 1/2 cup Epson salt and 1/2 cup baking soda in a glass jar. Add 30 drops of your favorite essential oil and mix. Add 1/4 cup scoop to the washer for each load.

LAUNDRY SOAP

In a 32 oz pump bottle, fill 1/2 of the bottle with Thieves Laundry Soap, add 6 caps of <u>Thieves Household Cleaner</u>. Fill with warm water and 20 drops of essential oil of choice for scent. Use 4 pumps per load of laundry

DRYER BALL SPRAY

In a 4 oz spray bottle, add tbsp witch hazel and 20 drops of your essential oil of choice. Shake and spray on dryer balls before placing them in the dryer. <u>Purification</u> is my favorite for this!

Honemade Caundry Soap

Don't have access to the options above or want to make your own to save money? I got you!

INGREDIENTS

4.5 ounces shaved bar soap (I like Thieves or Dr. Bronner's soap bars)

14 ounces borax

14 ounces washing soda

DIRECTIONS

Thoroughly stir together for several minutes and enjoy the results!

You can take this a step further and blend the mixture in a blender or food processor to create a powder that will dissolve easily even in cold water. (Just be sure to let the dust settle before removing the lid of your blender or food processor so you don't inhale the fine particles.)

Store in a sealed container with a small scoop.

Each batch yields approximately 32 ounces (between 32-64 loads based on how many Tbsp used per load).

Use 1 Tbsp per small load (or 2-3 Tbsp for large or heavily soiled loads).





FUN FACT! You DO NOT need toxic dryer sheets to get rid of static in your clothes. Static is created after your clothes are dry and they continue to dry. The best thing to do is figure out the timing when your clothes dry and stop it before static forms (may take some time to test). Dryer balls are also great for eliminating static (about 3-5 balls at a time, because they lower the dryer time by creating space for your clothes. You can use dryer balls with essential oils or Pure ECO Sheets.

P.S You also don't need laundry softener! If you are using a clean laundry detergent that does not contain harsh chemicals, your clothes will last longer and feel softer. Honestly, softener is just another marketing scam. It IS NOT NEEDED. You can just add a 1/2 cup of vinegar in the softener section of your washer to give it more softening/ cleaning power and extra good scent.

CHECK OUT RECIPES BELOW!

LAUNDRY STRIPPING: This is an overnight deep soak in your bathtub in hot water with washing soda and plant based cleaning agents to remove buildup of chemicals and oils and then you wash it. This helps soften your clothes and is great for when you bring home thrifted or hand-me-down clothes that have a strong scent! This is something we could all do every 6 months to refresh our clothes.
